

Raleigh, NC, December 2007. Celestine Publishing, LLC announced the release of the second book in its series of new scriptural concordances. *Principles with Promise: Old Testament & New Testament* is the second in a succession of principle-based topical guides planned for release within the next two years. This publication of *Principles with Promise* catalogues the doctrines, values, and teachings found in the Bible and their associated references regardless of how they are interpreted and practiced by the various Christian denominations.

When its author and publisher, Vincent DiGirolamo was asked about this new book in the series, he commented, *“When I released the first book for Latter-day Saints, I was asked by several of my friends from a variety of Christian denominations if I was going to make one for them, where only the biblical principles were listed, I would respond, it’s already in the works*

To my knowledge, there are no other concordances on the market that organize scripture in this manner; a principle-centered topical guide. This series not only provides an easier way to locate favorite scriptures in a timelier manner when researching any topic, it identifies many of the core tenets valued as truth directly from the scripture.”

Principles with Promise: Old Testament & New Testament is slated for use by the remainder of the Christian world, which uses the Bible as the source of its core tenets. A hardcover version is in final editing and will be available for purchase in January 2008.

Each volume in the *Principles with Promise* series organizes principles similarly by key words, cross-references by similar subjects, and is arranged like a typical dictionary or concordance without regard to interpretation, practice or origin.

DiGirolamo went on to explain, *“Principles with Promise* also introduces an alternative technique for studying the scriptures. Though not an entirely new approach, it expands upon previous attempts by laying out the information in a fashion which provides the researcher with easier access to the desired data and in a manner that is more readily understood than many other concordances.”

Celestine Publishing has plans to publish *Principles with Promise: A Principle Centered Approach Towards Scripture Study* in 2008 which elaborates on DiGirolamo’s research regarding the inherent organization of principle categories, types and patterns, and suggests a new study approach for students on how to discover for themselves the simple truths of the gospel, which he adds, *“we all are students even if we don’t know it yet. Principles with Promise is intended to help us locate the information we seek more quickly than conventional concordances do today and in a principle centered way.”*
